Martin Grime, from K9 Training Academy Ltd. based at Harwell is a Subject Matter Expert and Expert Witness in relation to the use of canines in relation to Law Enforcement investigation of homicide and child abduction. His experience spans 10 years of military service, 22 years service within UK policing and 7 years full time consultancy with the US Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Martin's presentation will outline the proof of concept, scientific research, training, operational deployment, and case studies pertaining to detection dogs involved in the investigation of homicide and alleged abduction. The talk will be in two parts, the first half will cover science, training, and deployment, and the second half will concentrate on case studies. There will be time for questions at the end.
