## How to report a scam

**Email:** forward phishing emails to [report@phishing.gov.uk](mailto:report@phishing.gov.uk).

**Text:** report scam texts to 7726.

**Websites:** report to the National Cyber Security Centre <https://www.ncsc.gov.uk/section/about-this-website/report-scam-website>

When filling in an online form to protect yourself and your contact number please use the number 0333 88 88 88 instead of your own telephone number.

**Phone call:** report suspicious phone calls to Action Fraud [www.actionfraud.police.uk](http://www.actionfraud.police.uk) or call 0300 123 2040. Register on Telephone Preference Service by calling 0345 070 0707.

**Doorstep crime:** if in immediate danger then call 999 or report to Trading Standards using <https://www.citizensadvice.org.uk/consumer/scams/reporting-a-scam/> or phone 0808 223 1133.

If you think you've shared your banking details – **contact your bank immediately** – and report to Action Fraud [www.actionfraud.police.uk](http://www.actionfraud.police.uk) or call 0300 123 2040.
