ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14(1)

Notice of Temporary Traffic Order Clifton Hampden-High Street Prohibition of Through Traffic Date of Order: 1 March 2021 Coming into force: 8 March 2021

This Order is being introduced because of repairs to traffic signals and embankments. which are anticipated to be completed on 5 April 2021.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle proceeding in the whole length of the High Street.

Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via High Street-Sires Hill-B4016-Appleford Road-Church Street-Drayton Road-High Street-Abingdon Road-B4017-Ock Street-A415-Abingdon Road and vice versa

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
