OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LONG WITTENHAM PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER **

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order – in support of road safety – is to amend existing speed limits in Long Wittenham as follows:

A. 30mph speed limits:

- 1. <u>Long Wittenham Road</u> extend the existing 30mph speed limit northwards by an additional 55 metres.
- 2. <u>Little Wittenham Road</u> introduce a 250 metre buffer limit in place of the current 60mph National speed limit, eastwards from the existing 20mph speed limit, adjacent to the Nature Reserve car park.

B. 40mph speed limit:

3. <u>Long Wittenham Road</u> – replace the current 60mph National speed limit between the existing 30mph speed limit at Clifton Hampden & the extended 30mph at Long Wittenham.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Long Wittenham Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2021 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
