# Oh no, not another plan

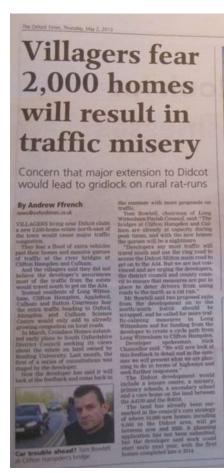
- 2004 Housing survey

# So why do we need a new plan?

  - North Didcot Development
  - Science Vale and economic strategy
  - SODC local plan 2031

# Giving us a say over our future

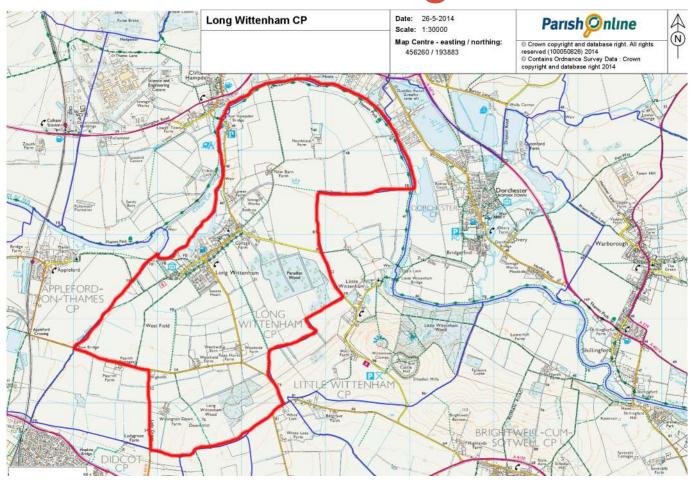
- A neighbourhood plan will enable us to raise our profile and create policies on:-

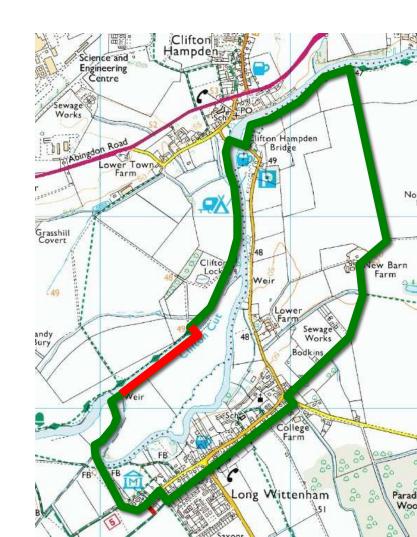
# The area we're thinking about





### A 4 mile circular walk

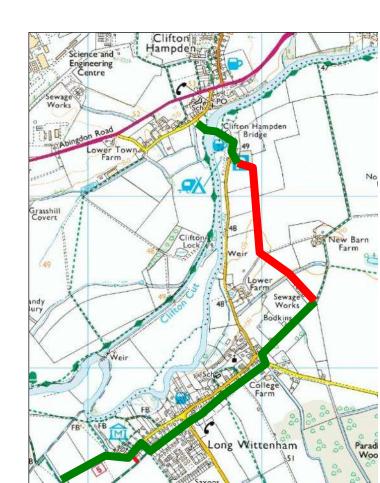
- Starting at the Barley Mow, would be a great facility for locals as well as bringing in visitors
  - Needs agreement from landowners
  - Probably need fence on island to separate cattle which needs funding
  - Thames Water ok for weir to be crossed





# Path/Cycle way to Clifton Hampden

- Tarmac cycle/walking path to Clifton Hampden
  - Needs agreement from landowners
  - Funding for tarmac area
- Can this be incorporated into the Science Vale cycle strategy
